





Routes to open access



Journals - Version of Record

- Includes journals managed by commercial or not-for-profit publishers
- May require payment of fee (which may be covered by institutional agreements)

Repositories - Author Accepted Manuscript

- Includes repositories managed by institutions
- Rights retention statement for authors
- No fees



オープンアクセスへの道



ジャーナル - VoR:出版社最終版(正式に出版された論文)

- 商業出版社または非営利出版社によって管理されている ジャーナルを含む
- 料金の支払いが必要な場合がある(機関契約によってカバーされる場合もある)

リポジトリ - 著者最終稿 (受理された段階の原稿)

- 機関によって管理されているリポジトリを含む
- 著者の権利保持に関する記述
- 費用負担なし

Ongoing implementation

- Communicate the new requirements of NHMRC's OA Policy
- Require institutions to review open access policies to align
 - Support researchers to understand CC-BY licensing and its value
 - Encourage use of rights retention statements
- Promote a diversity of approaches to open access, including
 - Use of 'read and publish' arrangements where available
 - Community-led publishing models
 - Institutional repositories
- Develop compliance and monitoring framework
- Recognise and reward open access practices.



継続して取り組んでいること

- NHMRCのオープンアクセス方針の新要件の周知
- 教育機関へのオープンアクセス方針の見直しを義務付け
 - 研究者がCC-BYライセンスとその価値を理解することを支援
 - 著作権保持に関する意思表明の利用を促進する
- オープンアクセスへの多様なアプローチを推進する
 - もし提供がある場合は「Read & Publish」契約モデルを活用
 - コミュニティ主導の出版モデル
 - 機関リポジトリ
- コンプライアンス順守のためのモニタリングができる環境を構築する
- オープンアクセスの実践を評価し、対価を提供する
