### **Purpose:**

This API is provided by CHORUS to be used by Funders, Agencies, or any other interested party to view screen shots of how publishers are prompting authors to submit their accepted manuscripts to their granting agency.

#### **Basic Mechanism:**

To use this document, you should be familiar with API concepts. All APIs return response as JSON by default. In case a response is need in XML the Content-Type of the request header needs to be set to either text/xml or application/xml.

#### **Optional Query Parameters:**

Parameter	Description	
member_id	CrossRef Member ID for each Publisher	
publisher	Publisher Name	

### Note(s): query parameters are optional

- If none of the query parameters are passed with the API call the prompt screen data for all publishers is returned.
- If member\_id is passed as query parameter, prompt screen data for publisher whose member id matches with id passed is returned.
- If publisher is passed as query parameter, prompt screen data for publisher whose name
  matches with the one passed as query parameter is returned. (publisher name should be
  url-encoded while passing as a parameter)
- If both member\_id and publisher are passed as query parameter, only member\_id will be considered and matching record will be returned. If member\_id passed does not exist in the database, a 404 error will be returned without checking for publisher query parameter.

Response Statuses:

200 -Successful

400 – If queried publisher does not exist. This happens in case member\_id or publisher passed as query parameter does not exist in the database

500 -Server errors

#### **Example cURL requests:**

Query data for all publishers:

curl "https://api.chorusaccess.org/publishers/prompt-screens"

Query data by member id:

curl "https://api.chorusaccess.org/publishers/prompt-screens?member\_id=263"

Query data by publisher name:

curl -G "<a href="https://api.chorusaccess.org/publishers/prompt-screens" --data-urlencode">https://api.chorusaccess.org/publishers/prompt-screens</a>" --data-urlencode "publisher=Institute of Electrical & Electronics Engineers (IEEE)"

**Note:** It is necessary to url-encode the publisher name as above when requesting data by name
